ROMANS 1:1-7: MARKS OF A REAL CHRISTIAN

There have only been two empires of trust, and they were both Republics: Rome and America. It is to a church living in the center of world power that Paul writes - to a country and culture which influenced the rest of the world.

This is an epic letter addressed to a diverse, integrated church. What Romans shows us is, we can influence the course of our country by making our countrymen disciples. Paul brings us theological truth for our end times.

Take as your assignment this week to read 2 chapters a day of Romans, and 3 on the weekend days.

4. Why is Jesus mentioned as to his connection with God (v 4)? 1 Pet 3:18; 2 Cor 13:4

5. How are we "obedient to the faith" (v 5)? 2 Cor 10:3-5; Heb 5:7-9

6. You are also called by Jesus Christ (v 6). Describe what that means (not to you, but according to the Bible adjectives), Rom 8:28-30; 1 Cor 1:9; Gal 1:6; 2 Thes 2:12; 2 Tim 1:9; Heb 3:1; 1 Pet 2:9,21; Rev 7:14

7. What should you do as we study this truth for our end times? 2 Pet 1:10-11
