Phil 2:13,15 For it is God which worketh in you both to will and to do of his good pleasure. **15** That ye may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world;

Phil 2:12-16 Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling. For it is God which worketh in you both to will and to do of his good pleasure. Do all things without murmurings and disputings: that ye may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world; **16** holding forth the word of life; that I may rejoice in the day of Christ, that I have not run in vain, neither laboured in vain.

1 Cor 12:9 To another faith by the same Spirit;

2 Co 4:13 We having the same spirit of faith

Gal 5:5 For we through the Spirit wait for the hope of righteousness by faith.

Gal 5:22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, ...faith,

2 Tim 1:7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love

Rom 5:5 And hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us.
